Rehoboth Beach Trip 2024





Monday, June 10th — Friday June 14th, 2024

Do you want to go on vacation with The Arc? We will be making our annual trip to Rehoboth Beach, Delaware, on **June 10th-14th, 2024**.

We will be staying at The Admiral on Baltimore with a coastal or beach view. It is about ½ a block from the beach and boardwalk. A 2-minute walk from the Rehoboth Avenue and Boardwalk bus stop, a 6 minutes walk to Funland amusement park. There is no need to cross any streets to get there! The Admiral is a beautiful hotel with an indoor pool (not handicap accessible) and sundeck. All rooms have two queen size beds and free Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs, as well as minifridges, microwaves, and coffeemakers.

Once we arrive in Rehoboth Beach you will be on your own to do what you would like.

<u>Each self-advocate must have a caregiver with them for the duration of the trip</u>. The caregiver is responsible for the self-advocate from the beginning of the trip and for getting them home after we come back from the trip. The Arc will <u>not</u> be responsible for bringing any self-advocates home after the trip.

Pick up is <u>Monday June 10th, 8 a.m.</u> from <u>Beiter's parking lot, Sunbury,</u> <u>North 4th Street</u>. Return trip= <u>Leaving Rehoboth at 11 a.m. Friday morning</u>. Actual return time is approximated depending on traffic (Usually between 5-5:30 p.m.).
